

We are replacing our usual Autumn Show with an online version. Start sending your entries in now!

### How to take part

- Exhibitors take photos of their exhibits and email them to Sue (Sue.Alexander99@btconnect.com) any time **before** 5pm on **Sunday 5 September**.
- Our judge reviews the exhibits anonymously. "Best in Show" awarded for each of the four sections –
  Flowers, Vegetables, Fruit and Crafts. No points will be awarded and no points accumulated towards any annual cups.
- Autumn Show Gallery on the EHS website will display the exhibits with exhibitor's name and awards during week commencing 13 September.

#### Rules

- 1. Exhibits are photographed either in a vase, or in your garden, unless a vase, dish or plate is stated.
- 2. All photographs of exhibits are to taken after 1 July 2021.
- 3. Exhibits which were entered in the Spring or Summer Online Show are to be excluded from this Show.
- 4. Exhibits are not judged on the quality of the photograph. The photograph needs to portray the exhibit clearly. It should display the exhibit close up, as if it was on the show bench. For example, take the image in a good light, use a plain background, avoid the surrounding room or garden.
- 5. Exhibits must be grown by the exhibitor.
- 6. Maximum of 3 entries per class from each exhibitor.
- 7. All\_entries to be submitted by 5 pm on Sunday 5 September but please send as soon as possible!
- 8. Each entry to be clearly annotated with exhibitor's name and class number.
- 9. Each exhibitor to have current 2020/21 red membership card. Renewals can be arranged by post or by visiting the Trading Hut prior to Show Date, 11 September.

### Flowers Section -

- Class 1 Chrysanthemum, large flowered, 1 bloom
- Class 2 Chrysanthemums, large flowered, 3 blooms, 1 or more varieties
- Class 3 Dahlia, 1 bloom
- Class 4 Dahlias, 3 blooms, 1 or more varieties
- Class 5 Dahlias, vase of 9 arranged facing forward, 1 or more varieties
- Class 6 Fuchsia, 1 pot
- Class 7 Fuchsia, 3 blooms in container, 1 or more varieties
- Class 8 Rose, single flowered, 1 bloom
- Class 9 Rose, cluster flowered, 1 bloom
- Class 10 Mixed flowers, not less than 3 varieties, arranged facing forward
- Class 11 Any other flower, 1 kind, 3 stems
- Class 12 Pelargonium, 1 pot
- Class 13 Flowering plant(s) growing in a tub, pot or in the ground

### Vegetables Section – one variety on a plain plate, unless stated otherwise

- Class 14 A basket of vegetables, not less than 4 kinds, shown for quality and to best effect in photograph
- Class 15 Carrots, 3
- Class 16 Courgettes, 3
- Class 17 Cucumbers, 2
- Class 18 Culinary herbs in a vase, 1 or more varieties
- Class 19 Lettuces, 2
- Class 20 Onions or shallots, 3
- Class 21 Potatoes, 4
- Class 22 Runner Beans, 6
- Class 23 Tomatoes, 4 small
- Class 24 Tomatoes, 4 medium
- Class 25 Any other vegetable, at least 2

### Fruit Section – one variety on a plain plate

- Class 26 Apples, dessert, named, 4
- Class 27 Apples, cooking, named, 4
- Class 28 Pears, 4
- Class 29 Any other fruit, at least 3

### **Crafts Section -**

- Class 30 Picture, painting, drawing or greeting card, any medium
- Class 31 Homemade item, any medium
- Class 32 Flower arrangement, arranged facing forward
